Horse Immersion campers have the opportunity to take the swim test, which includes 2 minutes of treading water followed immediately by a swim across the pond. Campers are monitored from the shore and pondside during the swim test.

Monday: Groundwork Horse/Pony Training, Partner with Barn Staff on chores to learn horse care.

Tuesday: Communication Games

Wednesday: Craft Day & Goal-Setting, or Creek Stomp

Thursday: Responsible Horse Care & Individual Expression

Friday: Overall Practice, Breakdown & Breakthroughs of Skills, or Break throughs to other farm areas.
